i-on160EX Software Version 3

We are pleased to announce that all new i-on160EX panels will be programmed with version 3 software. This new software will support the new engineering keypad, EXP-PSU and the two-way keyfob.

There are a number of changes to the installer menu including:

- Enable/Disable keypad and replace keypad
- Roller shutter functionality
- WAMs no longer assigned to partitions, these are now system devices (repeaters)
- New output type: Line Fault

Setting options now include:

- In a part setting system, each Full Set/Part Set now has its own siren delay, siren time, strobe on set/unset, and alarm Response. The PA response option is in System Options (no 'partition' menu option in 'part-set')
- In a partitioned system, the Full Set and Part Set of each partition also have their own siren delay, siren time, strobe on set/unset, and alarm Response.
- In addition, each partition also has its own PA response (in a partitioned system the PA response option does not appear in System Options).

System Options

- Remote Servicing (ARD)
- Dynamic test call option and static test call option are now mutually exclusive

New test options for:

- Radio Keypads
- Expanders
- EXP-PSUs
- Shock sensors
- Roller shutters
- Battery load test on demand
- Testing an ATS output now also starts a test call

Changes to the User Menu

- New System Config – Remotes option to enable/disable setting from remotes
